

# *Feminine Hygiene Kits*

The first shipment of kits to Peru were sent in December! Barb Whitaker went down to meet with doctors in December. No kits were be handed out, but will be stored until her trip in April. We have made 100 kits but the goal is to make 200 kits (we have 100 kits to go) for Barb to take to Peru when she returns there next April. Our next sew/work day is on **Tuesday, February 5**. We will start at 10:00 a.m. Stay as long as you like. Come later in the day as you like or are able. The church will be open until 4:00 p.m. Here are the jobs that need to be done:

- sewing/serging
- turning/pressing
- tracing/cutting
- installing snaps
- cutting/installing ribbon

Hopefully you can spare some time on **February 5**. We will have additional monthly work days, probably on the first Tuesday of the month, until we reach our goal. If you can come and have any of the following, please bring it with you that day:

- sewing machine and usual sewing supplies
- serger
- scissors that will cut fabric
- cutting mat, ruler and rotary cutter

**You do not have to have sewing skills! Just bring a scissors and come. We will train you.**

**There is also a way you can help with supplies.** Here is what we need:

- cotton fabrics, laundered and pressed, preferably medium to dark tones. Look through your scraps. Anything bigger than 4" x 4 1/2" can be used.
- flannel, laundered and pressed, preferably dark yardage.
- wash cloths

- girls' underwear, sizes 10 – 14
- gallon zip-loc bags
- small bars of soap
- money to purchase waterproof lining, snaps, etc.
