**LESSONS AND CAROLS**

**OPENING SENTENCES: Psalm 96 from the NRSV** Reader #1

**OPENING HYMN: “Once in Royal David’s City” #145**

**Once in royal David’s city stood a lowly, cattle shed,  
Where a mother laid her baby in a manger for a bed;  
Mary was that mother mild, Jesus Christ her little child.**

**We at last shall meet our Savior, fount of God’s redeeming

**FIRST LESSON: Genesis 3:8-15, 17-19** Reader #1

*Adam and Eve disobey God’s command and disrupt the order and  
goodness of creation.*

**CAROL: "O Little Town of Bethlehem" All 4 verses**

O little town of Bethlehem, how still we see thee lie;  
Above thy deep and dreamless sleep the silent stars go by:  
Let in thy dark streets shineth the Everlasting Light;  
The hopes and fears of all the years are met in thee tonight.

**FIFTH LESSON: Luke 1:26-35, 38** Reader #2
