SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

***THE INVITATION**

May God be with you.

And also with you

Open your hearts.

We open them to God and to One Another.

Let us give thanks to God.

It is right to give God thanks and praise.

Jesus, Divine Bread-Baker, each time we gather in memory to break this bread and drink this cup we share its richness in the midst of our poverty and we remember:

You are as the bread of our lives.

You are the One who enters in the hungry places of our hearts.

You are the One who invites us always to choose life, even when our world, and even our inner places, tastes of death, pain and weariness.

This bread, which binds us together, houses the sacred in common earthen gifts, proclaiming that the ordinary is but a mask of the holy.

CONSECRATION

Blessed are You, O God, for bringing us to this Table. We remember that night among friends, the night of deathly betrayal, when Jesus took bread, blessed it, broke it and share with his disciples, saying:

Take, eat, this is my body which is given for you. Do this to remember me.

Later in the evening, taking the cup, Jesus gave thanks and shared it, saying drink this all of you;

This is my blood of the new covenant poured out for you and the many.

Come now, unsettling Spirit of Hope, be present in the mystery of this Holy Meal and lead us out to follow the risk-taking Christ.

Because bread must be broken before it can be shared, we break this bread, remembering the brokenness of our world and declaring that our hope of wholeness and shalom is in Christ.

By eating this bread we become One in the hope.

We pour this wine, remembering the pain and bloodshed of our world and declaring our hope in the overflowing love of Christ.

By drinking this wine we become One in the hope.

DISTRIBUTION

Service this morning will be by intinction. Ushers escort you forward to a portion of bread which can be dipped in a chalice of wine or juice.

***PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING**

Blessed be God who has raised us and shaped us from the dust.

Blessed be God who has brought us to this table.

Blessed be God who has given us the bread of life.

Blessed be God who has fed us with the food of love.

Our hands and our hearts were empty.

Blessed be God who has filled us with hope.

Let us go out, risking the reality of the Gospel.

We go in the name of Christ.
