# **TOTENFEST**

Totenfest is celebrated the last Sunday of the Church Year and, in the old

German tradition, is the day for remembering those who have passed from this life into life eternal or whose funeral service was held during the last Church Year. (The Church Year begins on the First Sunday of Advent and ends the Sunday before Advent.)

Totenfest, literally "The Festival of the Dead", is the time set aside in our worship service to name our sisters and brothers who no longer answer the call in this life, to commemorate their passing with a rose, a candle is lit, and special prayers of thanksgiving are offered for their journey with us on this earth.
