A MESSAGE FROM YOUR CHURCH COUNCIL

WHO'S CLEANING THE CHURCH?

You may already know that our custodians, Bob and Steve, retired in November. Since then, members have been cleaning the church weekly – mostly Tom and Jan Miller. We are actively looking for a custodian to clean the church weekly. Right now, there is no lawn care to be concerned with.

What we are doing:

Until a custodian is found, we will continue to clean weekly--

- the sanctuary vacuum center aisle, chancel and under some of the pews, check areas that need to be dusted
- narthex dust mop the floor, empty waste baskets
- front hallway dust mop tile, vacuum rugs
- front restrooms
- \bullet Tom and Jan have spent about 1 ½ to 2 hours a week keeping those areas clean.

We propose: that one or two people sign up weekly or take up to a month at a time to keep the above areas clean. The cleaning will have to be done on Friday or Saturday. We have a private group that meets in the building on Thursday nights and we want to clean after they come, so that the church is completely clean for Sunday mornings.

The work isn't difficult, and we will show you where the equipment and products are stored. A sign-up sheet will be in the narthex on Sundays.

And -- if you see something that needs to be done, please step up and do it. Thanks.
